Thursday 22 June is our School Sports Day. This is a huge day for the P&C- all hands on deck would be greatly appreciated!



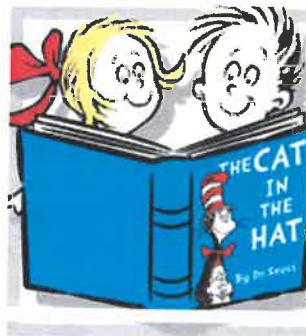

Electrical Circuits- Year 6 with Miss Larsen

In Science Year 6 have been learning about electrical circuits and energy sources. We also learnt about insulators and conductors and experimented with materials to determine whether they were insulators or conductors.

Reading Strategy : Visualising

To visualise means to see a picture in your head without actually looking at it.

Visualisation can help you learn almost anything. Here is an example. Let's say the topic is the water cycle. Create a mental image of a cloud. Picture it growing. Now see, and "feel" its heavy cold rain. See the rain hitting the ground, then flowing toward streams and rivers toward the ocean. Now "see" the hot sun hitting and evaporating the water and forming clouds... Get the picture? If you can visualize parts of the water cycle, the simple diagram becomes meaningful and memorable. If you have trouble visualising material, try drawing maps, charts, graphs, or pictures.

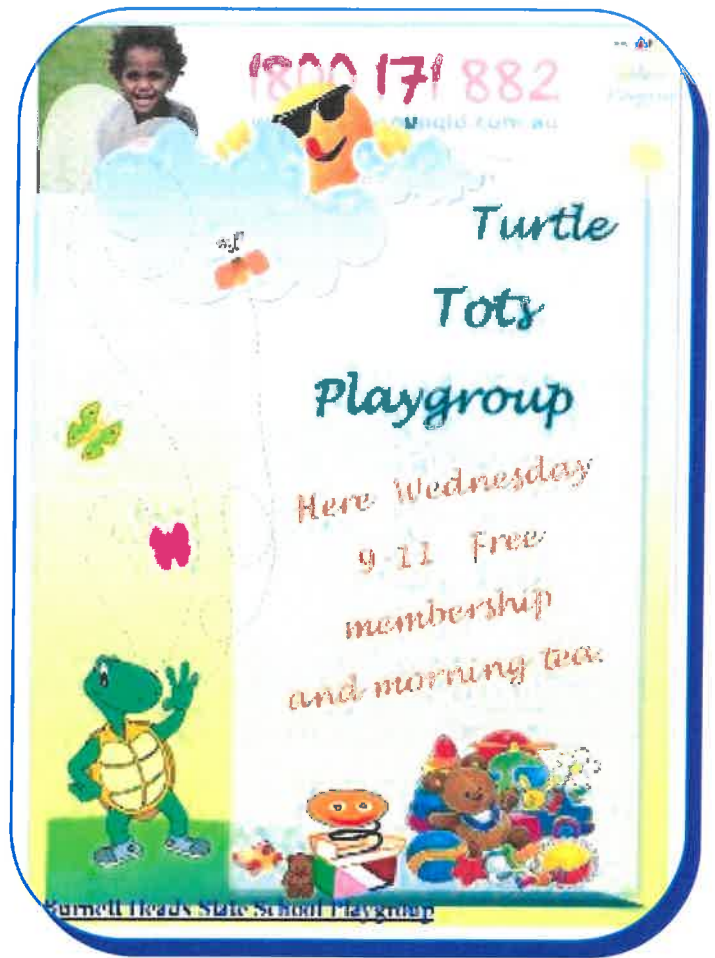
