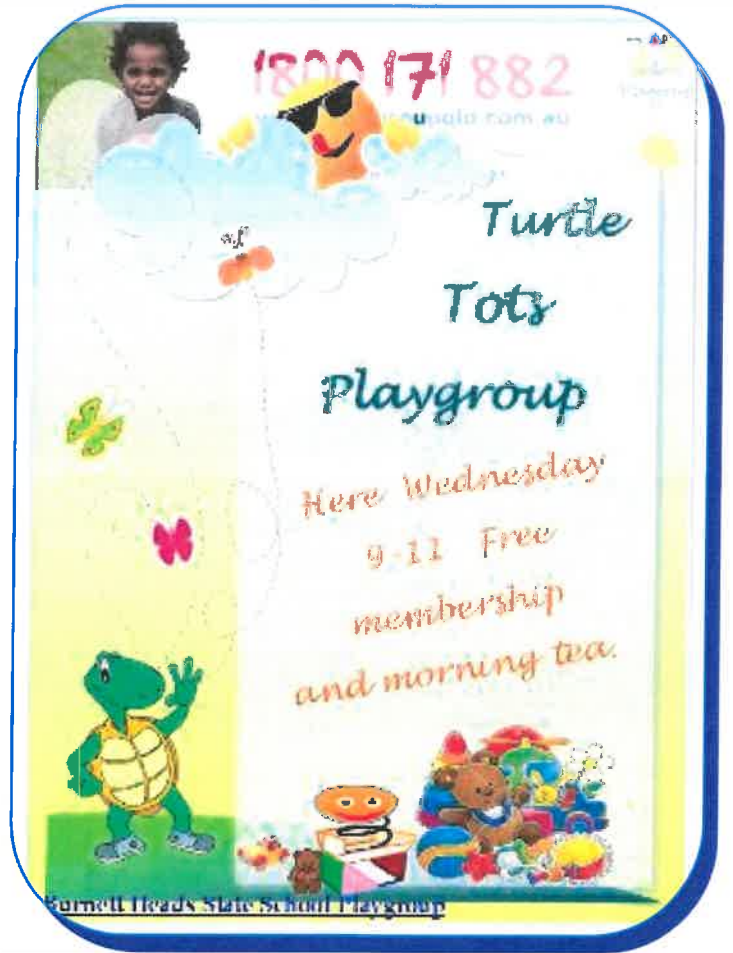


"I had the same thing happen to me ..."
