Circle of Security is a free 6 week parenting program that

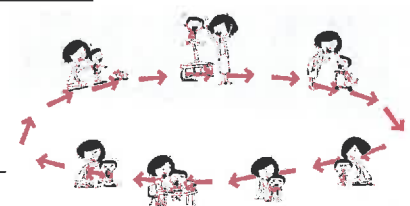
explores the connection between a parent/caregiver and their child. The program enables us as parents/caregivers to know what our children need from us.

Reading Strategy – SYNTHESISING

 **Synthesising**

- ★ Can you use what you have read in a new way?
- ★ Can you restate the ideas in your own words?

Synthesising – “My thinking grows and changes as I read.” Synthesising is combining what I know with new information to

present these thoughts in a new way.

We see synthesising when students come up with a new way of showing this new thinking. It might be the constructing of a new product based on information they have and information they have added. It might be sharing new thoughts acted out as a play, as a dance or as artwork. The reader might use what they now know to write a persuasive letter to change someone’s belief. This reading strategy brings pieces of information together to grow a new idea in the reader’s head.
