Circle of Security is a free 6 week parenting program that explores the connection between a parent/caregiver and their child.

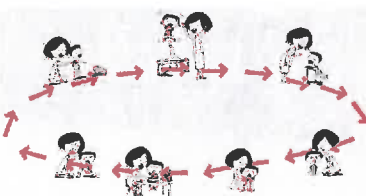

Students enjoying their Silver Rewards Day at Oaks Beach



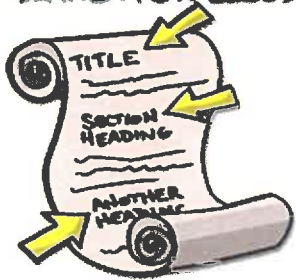

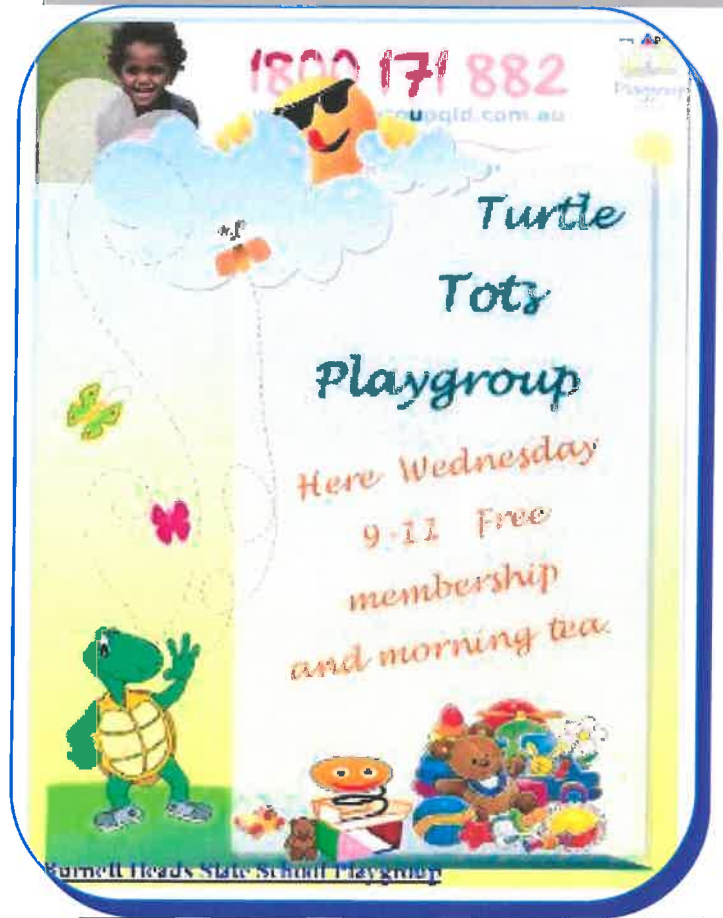
Reading Strategy – SKIMMING
