YEAR 6 WITH MISS LARSEN

Changing Matter

Year 6 have been investigating the states of matter and changing states of matter. We have conducted experiments to investigate melting (solid-liquid), solidifying (liquid-solid), dissolving (combining matter) and evaporating (liquid-gas). We learnt that oils solidify at different temperatures. Motor Oil doesn't solidify, whereas coconut oil solidifies at room/fridge temperature. Substances also have different melting points.

We also started exploring the different elements of art. We looked at colour (primary and secondary colours and warm and cool colours) and line.
