Dear Parents and Guardians,
I hope that families enjoyed the Lighthouse Festival on the weekend. It was very successful and was the result of very hard work by the Progress Association and all of the Community groups in the area, including our school. Well done to all involved who worked tirelessly to promote this event and the role of our school in the community. See photos and article on the back page. This Friday is Day for Daniel. For the first time, Burnett Heads will be involved in this day's activity, which emphasises an awareness of child safety. The Day for Daniel child safety curriculum is now officially part of the Australian Curriculum. Red is the traditional colour for Day for Daniel, and we encourage all students to wear red although students going to sport will need to bring their uniform shirt as well. Police from Bargara station will attend the school at 11:15 to address our school students about how to stay safe in all environments, and who to count on if they do not feel safe. This event precedes Halloween Night, and will be a reminder to children about safe behaviour when trick or treating. On Friday morning also, we have our annual Indigenous performance. This year, the performer is Lewis Parter from Murri-Kulcha in Education. There is no cost to attend this performance. Next week, we begin the first session of our Pre Prep Play which is extended to all students enrolling in Prep next year. This spreads over 4 weeks, each time on a Thursday afternoon from 1:30 until 3 pm. Please advise the Office if you know of Prep aged students in the area.
