Dear Parents and Guardians

As we draw close to the end of Term, it is time to recognise those students who have met the criteria for Bronze for Term 1. For 6 weeks of the term, students who reach this level will have been model students who have demonstrated our school rules in their behaviour in and out of the classrooms, have attended regularly and explained absences when they have occurred, completed homework and tried to the best of their ability in all areas. Certificates acknowledging these students will start to be presented this week, and our Bronze Day celebration will take place next Thursday in the middle session. During this session, staff convert the area behind C block into a water slide, pool and general wet play area for our Bronze awardees. The P&C complete the session by offering an ice block.

Attending this also depends on behaviour and that will be negotiated with individual students. Entry will be \$5.00.
