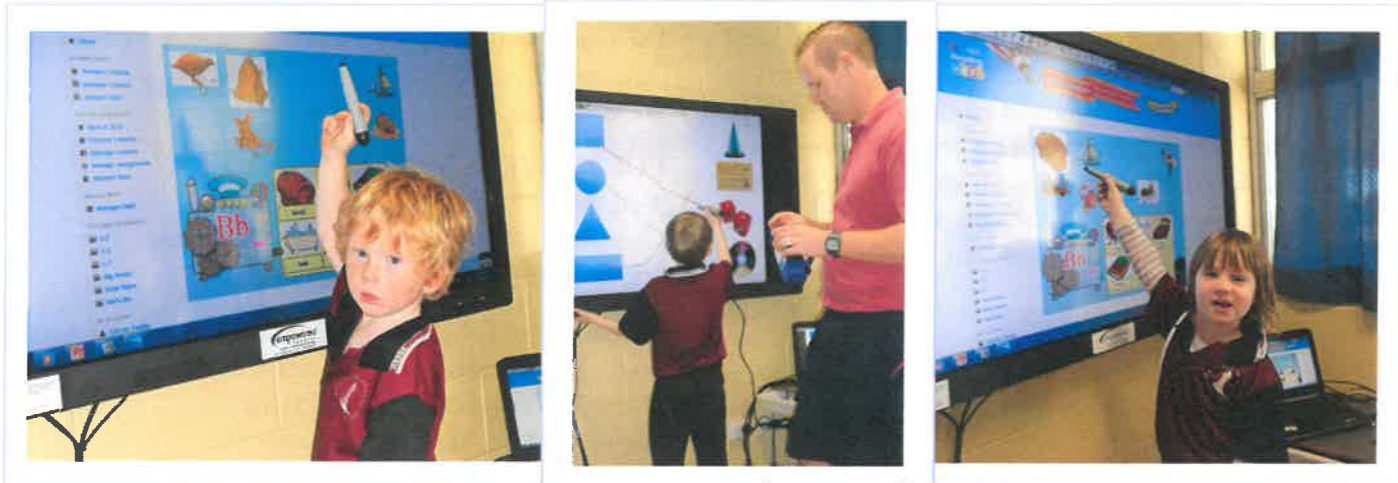

Dear Parents and Guardians
