The Naplan results have been given preliminary examination. Grammar and Punctuation was the best result. The progress graph for each student from Year 3 to Year 5 was pleasing, with students making substantial gains across the board. We use the Naplan data as part of a range of data gathered to plan our Improvement Agenda for the coming years. Parents also should not take the results in isolation, but view them in context of what you know of your child's learning. Our Prep enrolments are now open for 2016. If you have a student who turns 5 by June 30 2016, they are ready for Prep. We are looking forward to meeting the new little people who will be commencing their education with us.

The athletics season has finished for 2015. Our students acquitted themselves very well in all events at Salter Oval and have the place cards to prove it. The relay teams were particularly successful, while we shared in the trophy for Ball Games for 2015. The trophy is being looked after by Elliott Heads and we will do our best to win it outright next year when we have larger numbers in the upper school.
