READING STRATEGY: Using Analogy

Analogy is a reading strategy we use to identify unknown words by thinking about what we know about familiar words and transferring it to the new word. Analogy is using what I know about words to grow word families e.g. I know **cat** so I will use that to help me to recognise **hat, splat** and **vat**.

I will use the meaning of the words I know in the text to help me to read on or reread to unlock the unknown words e.g. The 'house' galloped down the street. The **horse galloped** down the street. My knowledge of the word galloped helps me to see my error when I read 'house'.

This strategy is explained with examples in our Student Notices on the Burnett Heads HOME page.
