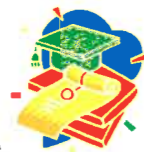

The Easter Raffle will be our next fundraiser. Tickets will be handed out to families early March. Donations for this raffle would be greatly appreciated.

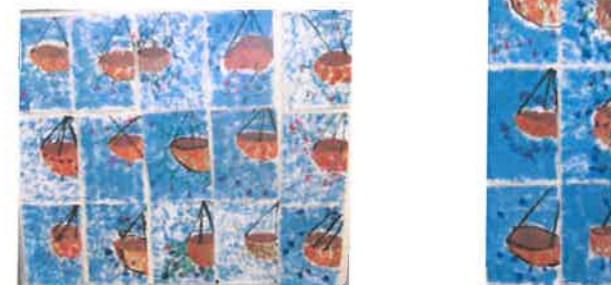
YEAR 6 ART
