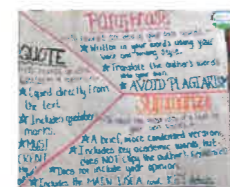
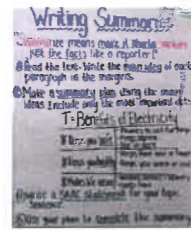

READING STRATEGIES: PARAPHRASING and SUMMARISING

We are learning about *Paraphrasing* (Retelling) and *Summarising* to be able to share the author's message? If you were asked to explain something you have just read, what would you say?

If we are **PARAPHRASING** or **RE-TELLING** we need to tell it in our own words. Our retelling shows someone that we understand the message or our retelling can help someone to understand the message.

When we **SUMMARISE** we need to shrink the author's words down to **key words** so we can turn it back into a sentence later.

Parenting – setting boundaries, planning for change, managing resistance to change, role modelling and how to be balanced and consistent.

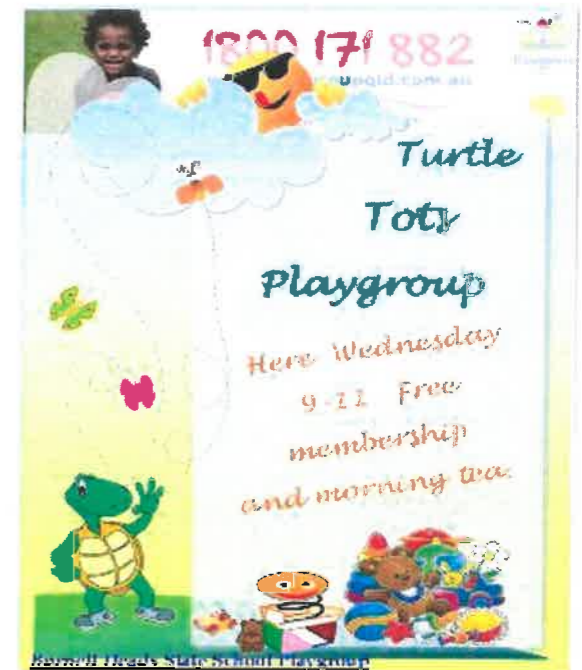
Family focus – the program recognises that each family is different and so our facilitators work with individuals to come up with a plan that suits them.
