VISIT FROM CIRCA

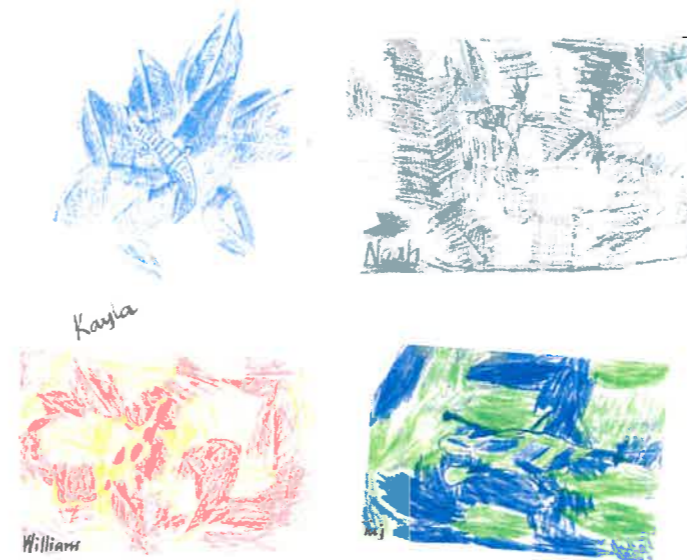
