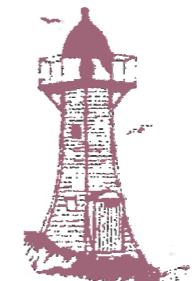

Dads Read is an early childhood literacy initiative, developed by State Library of Queensland to promote opportunities at home. An early start is the best start but it is never too late to start.



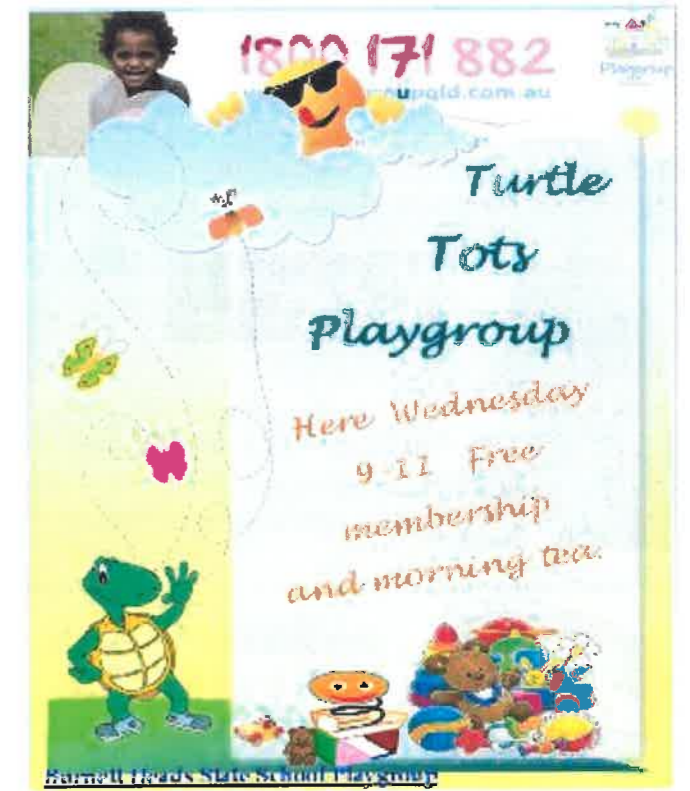
