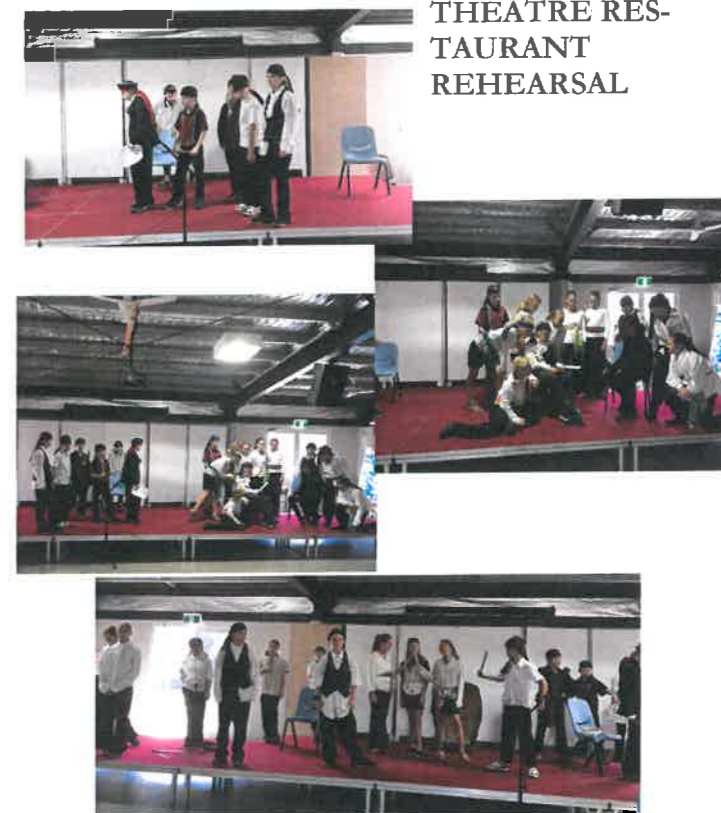
GARAGE SALE TRAIL

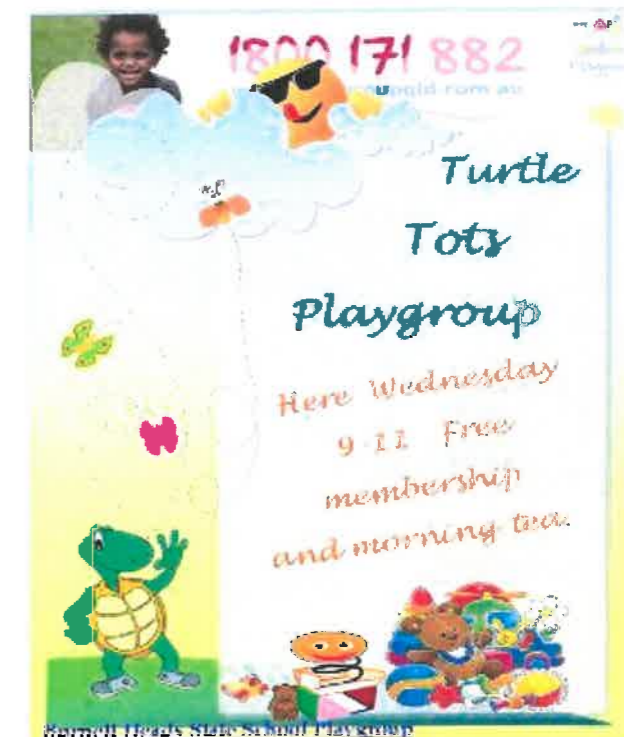
Rummage for Relay
