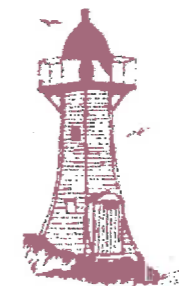

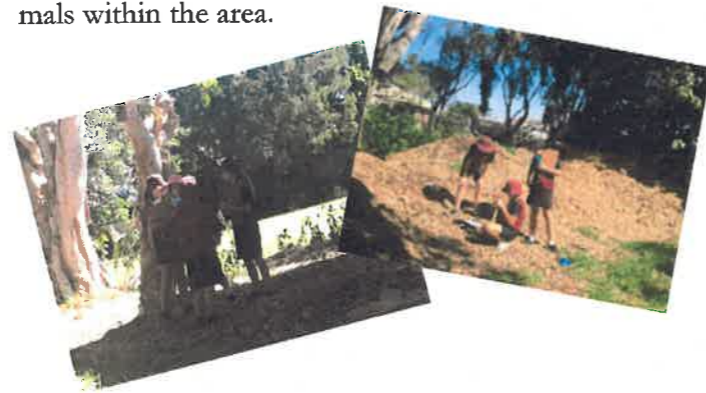

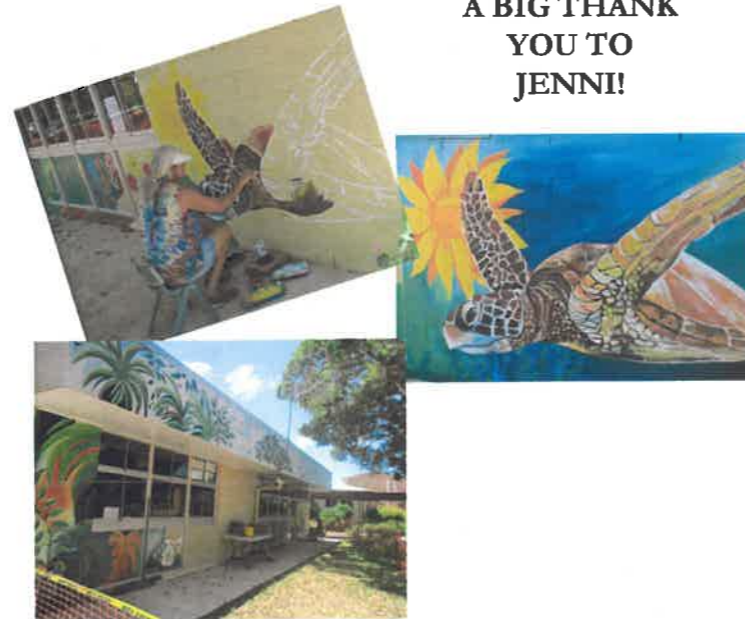


YEAR 6 FIELD STUDY
